The Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia has received a credit/financing from the International Development Associations (IDA), the Fast Track Initiative Catalytic Fund (FTI CF) and other development partners – the Netherlands, UK Department for International Development (DFID), Italian Development Cooperation and Finland – through a Multi-Donor Trust Fund toward the cost of the GEQIP Project and it intends to apply part of this proceeds to payments under the Contract for procurement of the textbooks and teacher guides listed below.

A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee ETB350 or USD20 or equivalent in freely convertible currency for the Bid Document. The method of payment shall be in cash or cashier's cheque payable to the MoE.
7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before, 2:00 pm, Friday 30, March 2012. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at 2:30 pm, Friday 30, March 2012.
8. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of USD 30,000.00 for each lot or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency of eligible countries. The bid security shall be in the form of a certified cheque, letter of credit or bank guarantee from a reputable banking institution or a bond issued by a surety; be issued by a reputable institution selected by the Bidder and located in any eligible country. If the institution issuing the bond is located outside the Purchaser's Country, it shall have a correspondent financial institution located in the Purchaser's Country to make it enforceable.
9. A Pre-Bidding Conference will be held at the Ministry of Education, Arat Kilo, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, on Wednesday, February 29 2012. All Bidders who have purchased Bid Document will receive a written invitation to attend the Pre-Bidding Conference.
